



Live Painting:

The first two sizes will be completed on site, and the other sizes will be completed after the event in my studio. The largest two sizes can include the wedding party and guests. Due to space, I cannot allow for additional people in sizes 8x10-18x24.

Live Guest Painting

Watercolor paintings of your guests to take home as favors. I can typically create 10-13 paintings an hour. \$200 an hour with a minimum of 3 hours and up to 8 hours. These will be painted on 5x7 sheets of watercolor paper.

Thank You Cards

Cards will be 4.25 x 5.5 horizontal or vertical depending on your painting and will include envelopes. Envelopes can have the return address printed on them if you would like.

How do I book?

The first step to booking is filling out the questionnaire I will send once you are ready. The questionnaire gives me all of the information I need to create your unique experience and calculate your total. In order to reserve your date, a non-refundable retainer is required. The retainer is 50% of the total.



What should I expect on the day of my event?

I will arrive 1-2 hours before the start time. I will set up my easel. I usually take a few photos to get a feel for how the space will fit 2 dimensionally, and I may even create a few sketches. Once I'm confident with the composition, I will begin laying out the "skeleton" of the painting. If you have chosen oil paint, I will usually begin laying down color before guests arrive. If I am using acrylic, I will wait to add color once guests begin to arrive. I work on the painting for 4-6 hours on site.

What if my event is cancelled or postponed?

If the event is cancelled the retainer is non-refundable. Any amount paid over the 50% retainer will be refunded. If the event is postponed, any payment received can be transferred to another available date. In the event that I cancel on you, the client, any payment will be fully refunded.

Can I have both the live wedding painting and the live guest painting?

Yes, however, I will not be able to do a reception/first date painting. The reception is the best time for the live guest painting. I would be able to capture the ceremony and complete it later in my studio.

When will I get my painting back?

8x10s and 11x14 will be given to a designated person the night of the event, unless you have selected greeting cards to be made from the final painting. All other paintings will return to my studio with me and will be completed in 3-6 months. Be sure to check social media to see updates.



When will I receive my greeting cards?

Greeting cards can take up to 4 weeks after the completion of the painting to be made and printed. A high resolution image will be created of the painting, if you need more cards and/or prints, please contact me for the highest quality print.

What is included?

A finished painting of your wedding in either oil paint or acrylic created with archival, museum-quality materials, giving you a family heirloom to carry on the heritage of your love.
4-6 hours of on-site live painting, providing entertainment for your guests.

A virtual or in person coffee date with me before the event to discuss your vision for the painting, I can answer questions, and I can better capture your likeness in the painting.

What should I expect on the day of the event?

I will arrive at your event 2-3 hours before it begins to lay out the composition of your painting. I will have a drop cloth for indoor events and all of my painting supplies. I will paint live at your event for 4-6 hours. Please be sure that there is 5'x5' space for me to set up my supplies for the ceremony and the reception.

If you have selected the live guest painting package, I will bring a small table to set up at with my watercolor supplies. Guests will be able to stand nearby for me to capture their likeness, they will be able to take that small painting home with them as a unique favor.

What is the difference between oil and acrylic paint?

Acrylic paint dries quickly, and allows me to move more quickly during the event. I can capture more detail with acrylic, but it has less texture. Oil takes much longer to dry and does not allow me to complete as much of the painting the night of the event. Oil has more texture, but less detail. 8x10 and 11x14 paintings will only be painted with acrylic. See the next page for examples of oil and acrylic paint.
